This new font brings more easily readable text to the higher resolution screens that are commonly seen on newer machines, while still filling the complete screen with a reasonable number of characters. If you like the Spleen font, you can use it in your xterminals by installing the fonts/spleen port with `doas pkg_add spleen`. More details can be found on Frederic's website. Those who prefer the old (or other) fonts while in console mode are invited to read the `wconscctl(8)` manpage.
