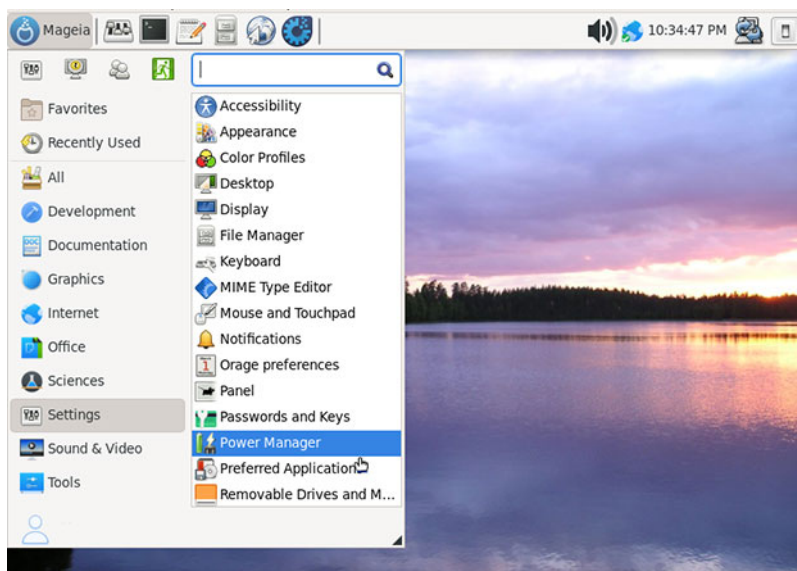


Mageia 7 Pushes Linux Desktop Boundaries
