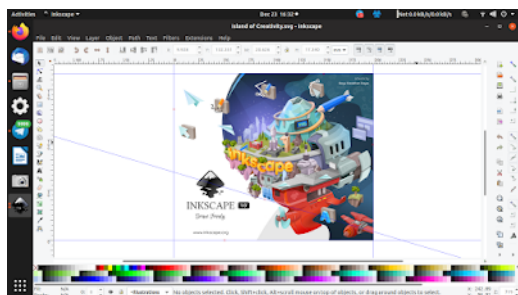


# Introducing Inkscape
