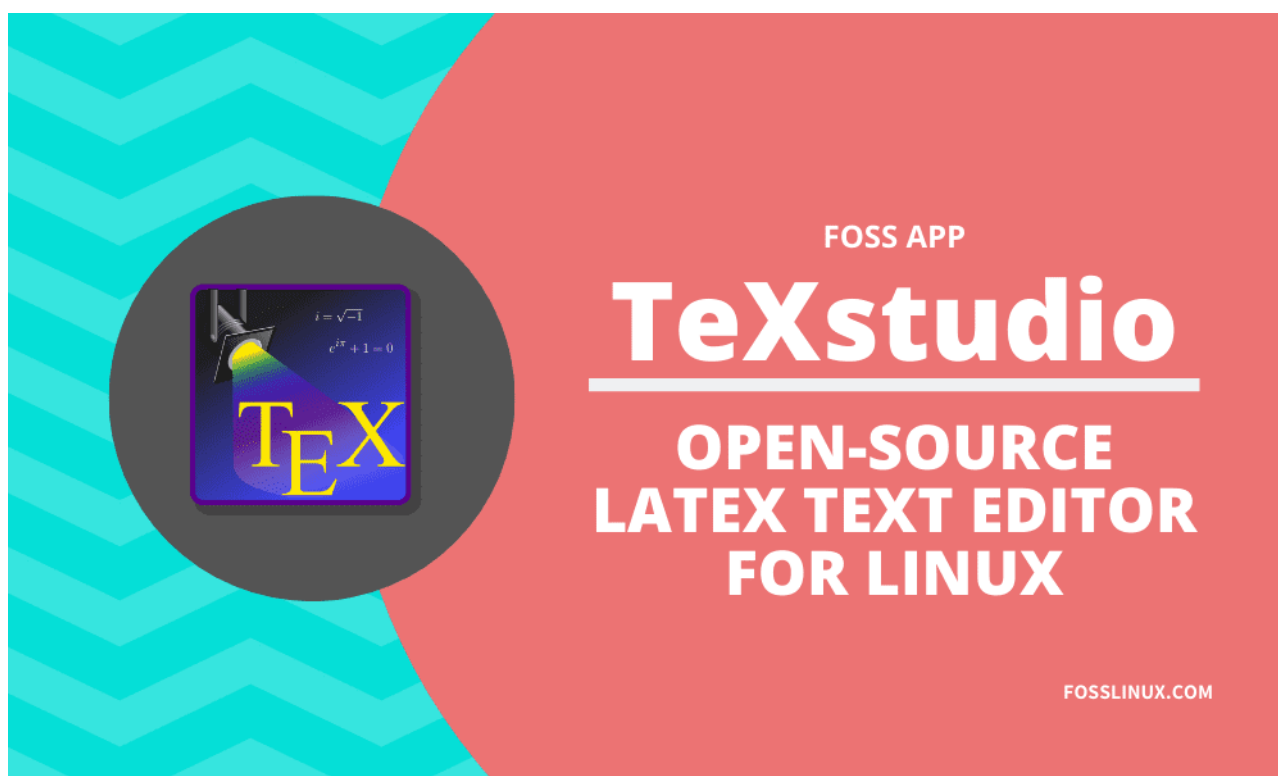


TeXstudio: Open-source LaTeX text editor for Linux

LaTeX is a handy document preparation system. For those of you who don't know, it is a system in which you can specify the components of a document, without having to format it yourself.
