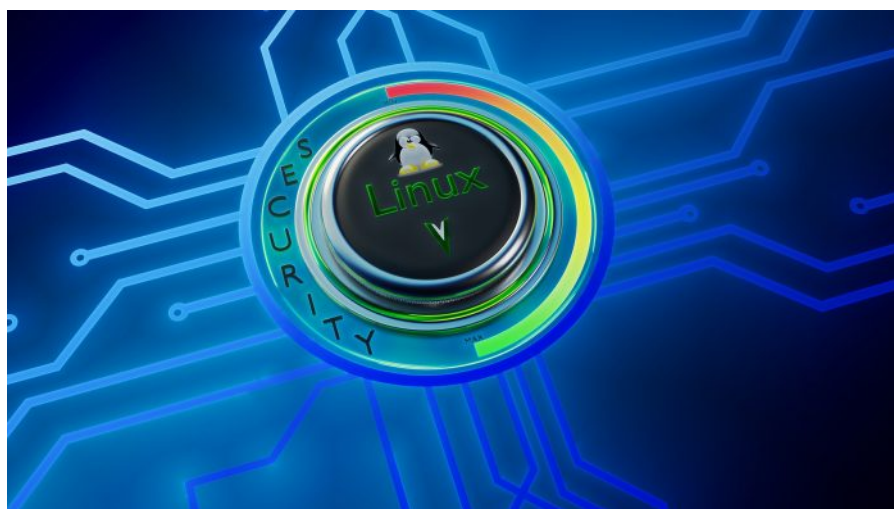


6 Best Ways to Improve Linux Security
