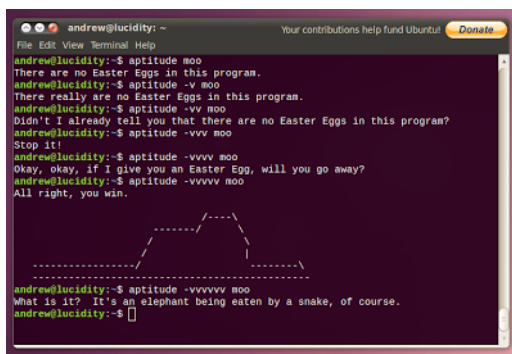
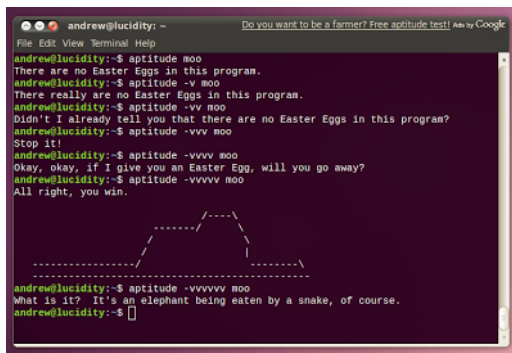


"There's nothing that will convince your boss you're working," explained Mr. Gooley-Aubergine, "like the familiar sight of a *real* operating system like Windows XP."

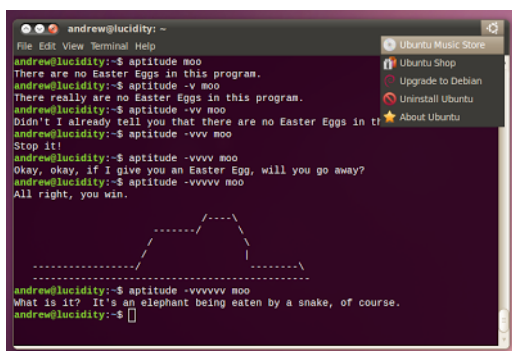
