Recently, a really, *really* long <u>discussion</u> [2] took place on <u>Launchpad</u> [3], Ubuntu's bug-tracking system, about the Ubuntu user interface design team's sudden and controversial decision to move window buttons from the right-hand side to the left. 
But what "innovative options" might he be referring to?

For example, there might be an implementation of a <u>boss key</u> [8] by means of the face icon in the upper right-hand corner. In this use-case scenario, explained Mr. Gooey-Aubergine, when you clicked the icon your screen would immediately display the following:



"There's nothing that will convince your boss you're working," explained Mr. Gooey-Aubergine, "like the familiar sight of a *real* operating system like Windows XP."

According to Mr. Gooey-Aubergine, Mark Shuttleworth has been asking all Ubuntu teams to come up with possible ways to increase revenue. "That's a real natural for us, as opposed to, say, those eggheads in the kernel team," said Mr. Gooey-Aubergine. "We've been expecting this request for a long time now."
