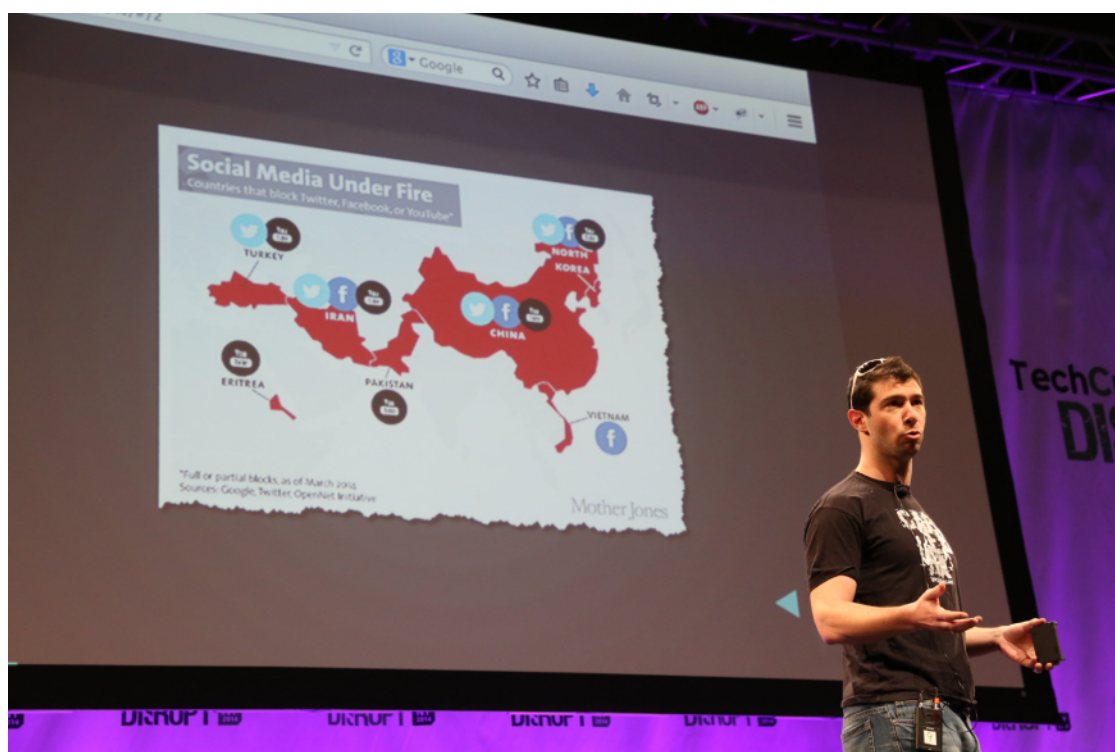


The oRouter Is A Tor-Powered Linux Box That Secures Your Internet Connection
